Education of Children Otherwise Than at School (Elective Home Education)

Parent Plan Form

This form is designed to help you think about some of the issues you will need to consider if you are to successfully educate your child/children at home. In planning your child's/children's education you might wish to consult the National Curriculum guidelines. It would be beneficial to establish clear routines for study and keep records or copies of all work. It is important to include opportunities for your child/children to have regular contact with other adults and children and to be able to take part in physical activities.

The Initial Parent Plan or the Educational Philosophy needs to be completed either online or returned to the Elective Home Education Officer, Plough Lane, Hereford, HR4 0LE or emailed to home-education@herefordshire.gov.uk.

The education of a child at home is permitted subject to certain conditions imposed by the Education Act 1996. Section 7 of the Act states:

“The parent of every child of compulsory school age shall cause him/her to have efficient full-time education suitable:

- a) to his/her age, ability and aptitude, and
- b) to any special educational needs he/she may have

either by regular attendance at school or otherwise.”

The last phrase “or otherwise” covers proposals for the education of children at home. Special educational needs cover a very wide spectrum of educational difficulties.

Under Section 437 of the Education Act 1996, the Local Education Authority has a responsibility to check that parents are carrying out the duties imposed on them by Section 7 referred to above.
